The number of the male, female, and total persons 10 years of age or over born in each state or country, and falling under the following classes, are shown: Persons who read and write English; persons who read and write some other language than English, but who do not read and write English; and illiterates. The first and second divisions of the table represent the literate class, the third division the illiterate class, while both classes are summed up in the last division. The most important point to be considered in this connection is to ascertain for both the native and foreign born population of the districts canvassed what percentage of persons 10 years of age or over is illiterate.
